

**LOCAL LAW #2 OF 2015
A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW #4 OF 1995
PROVIDING FOR RECODIFICATION OF LOCAL LAWS OF
THE VILLAGE OF HORSEHEADS
(Residency for Police Chief and DPW Director)**

Adopted 5/14/15

BE IT ENACTED, by the Village Board of The Village of Horseheads as follows:

Section 1. Section 1-11, subsection (5) of Village of Horseheads Local Law #4 of 1995, duly adopted by the Village Board of the Village of Horseheads on November 16, 1995, is amended as follows:

“(5) Chapter 40, Officers and Employees, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a. Article II, Residency Requirements (former LL No. 1 of 1982), is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE II - Residency Requirements

Section 40-15. RESIDENCY IN THE VILLAGE. The person or persons who fill the offices of Village Manager and Clerk-Treasurer shall be or become, within one (1) year of the date of hire, residents of the Village of Horseheads. This provision shall apply to the person or persons who are hired to fill those offices on or after January 1, 1996.”

Section 2. If any part or provision of this local law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not effect or impair the validity of the remainder of this local law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Horseheads hereby declared that it would have passed this local law, or the remainder thereof, had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Section 3. All ordinances, local laws, rules and regulations and parts thereof inconsistent with this local law are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately.
