Credit cards and cash will be accepted. (Credit card fee will apply)

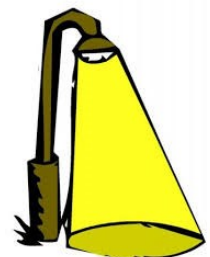
